Use of cookies on the bbodance website

When you visit some pages on the bbodance website, your computer may be issued with a small file called a "cookie". A cookie is a piece of information in the form of a very small text file that is placed on the hard drive of your computer. The information the cookie contains is set by the server (this website) and it can be used by that server whenever you visit this website. The server uses cookies to recognise your browser session if you visit multiple pages during your interaction with this website.

You can set your browser to refuse cookies or warn you before accepting them. However, some parts of this website may not function properly without accepting cookies. <u>aboutcookies.org</u> gives some helpful information about how to adjust your browser settings in relation to cookies.

Session cookies

The bbodance website will primarily set session cookies. Session cookies allow websites to remember information from page to page so the user does not have to input that information more than once. The prime example of when session cookies are used is during a purchase from an internet shop — a session cookie would be used to remember what the user had put in their basket so that it would be carried through to checkout.

Session cookies will normally be deleted by your browser when the browser is closed.

Analytic cookies

Some parts of this website use Google Analytics which also place cookies on your computer. The information generated by these cookies about your use of this website will be transmitted to and stored by Google. For further information on these, please visit Google's website.

We may use and analyse this information so that we can manage and improve the services on the website. Demographic and statistical information about user behaviour may be collected and used to analyse the popularity and effectiveness of the website. Any disclosure of this information will be in aggregate form and will not identify individual users.

bbodance will not (nor will it allow any third party to) use the statistical analytics tools to track or to collect personally identifiable information of visitors to this website. bbodance will not associate any data gathered with any personally identifying information from any source as part of our use of the statistical analytics tools.

Social buttons

On many of the site's web pages you will see 'social buttons'. These enable users to share or bookmark web pages. There are buttons for Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn and X (formerly Twitter). In order to implement these buttons, and connect them to the relevant social networks and external sites, scripts from domains outside bbodance are used. You should be aware that these sites are likely to be collecting information about your internet browsing, including on the

bbodance site. So, if you click on any of these buttons, these sites will be registering that action and may use that information. In some cases, if you are logged into their services, these sites will be registering the fact that you are visiting our website, and the specific pages you are on, even if you don't click on the button. You should check the respective privacy and cookie policies of each of these sites to see how exactly they use your information and to find out how to opt out, or delete, such information.
